EPISTLE & GOSPEL

Vow ye and pay the Lord your God.
In Judah is God known.

The Epistle selection for today is for the seventeenth Sunday after Pentecost. The Reading is from Saint Paul's Second Letter to the Corinthians (6:16-7:1). BRETHREN, we are the temples of the living God; as God said, "I will live in them and move among them, and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. Therefore come out from them, and be separate from them, says the Lord, and touch nothing unclean; then I will welcome you, and I will be a father to you, and you shall be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty." Since we have these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from every defilement of body and spirit, and make holiness perfect in the fear of God.

The Gospel selection for today is for the seventeenth Sunday after Pentecost (Third Sunday of Luke). The reading is from the Holy Gospel according to Saint Luke (7:11-16). The next day Jesus went to a city called Nain, and his disciples and a great crowd went with him. As he drew near to the gate of the city, behold, a man who had died was being carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow; and a large crowd from the city was with him. And when the Lord saw her, he had compassion on her and said to her "Do not weep." And he came and touched the bier, and the bearers stood still. And he said, "Young man, I say to you arise." And the dead man sat up and began to speak. And he gave him to his mother. Fear seized them all; and they glorified God, saying, "A great prophet has arisen among us!"
